**NU FLOW AWARDED LARGE PIPE RESTORATION PROJECT
Combined Pipe and Sewer Restoration is No Longer a Pipe Dream**

Sarasota, FL – (August 23, 2007) – Pipe lining technicians for the Nu Flow Companies began water pipe and drain line restoration of the luxury retirement community of Plymouth Harbor on Sarasota Bay in Florida last month. The multi-million dollar contract is the largest combined technology project ever awarded in the small diameter pipe lining industry. The contract signifies a growing trend in the use of epoxy pipe lining to address deteriorating water infrastructure globally.

Established in 1966, Plymouth Harbor on Sarasota Bay is a non-profit, 25-story, multi-structure complex with full amenities and services, including its own skilled nursing facility. Home to judges, a Nobel Prize recipient, artists, clergy, academicians and CEOs of U.S. and international corporations, the community is distinguished by its innovative architectural design and the world-class services enjoyed by its mostly-senior residents.

Perched on 16 stunning acres of Florida coastline, Plymouth Harbor's facilities are first-class, and they take a proactive stance in maintaining the property and residents' comfort. When plumbing concerns arose, the Board's primary concern was minimizing disruption to residents, so the time, cost, and destruction of traditional re-piping were simply not feasible.

"We began investigating epoxy lining companies in the summer of 2006," said Harry Hobson, President and CEO of Plymouth Harbor. "Nu Flow was awarded the contract in April, 2007 based on their experience and reputation, and the fact that they were the only company capable of providing both drain and potable pipe lining."

"A project of this size and nature typically involves at least two lining companies," said Nu Flow President, Cameron Manners. "Re-piping would require multiple contractors to repair invasive damage and could take years to complete." Nu Flow's restoration of the entire inside infrastructure began in June and is slated for completion by late summer of 2008.
